Rainier Beach: Beautiful! is based on the idea that when adults actively teach, model, expect, and acknowledge positive behaviors for youth – the youths’ negative behaviors will decrease, and the overall climate in the community will improve.

This idea has been incorporated into a framework called Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports, or **PBIS**. **PBIS** is used in over 20,000 schools around the country and is proven for reducing suspensions and discipline referrals and for improving academic performance, attendance, perception of safety, and organizational health of schools.
